FAQ's

How will I communicate with my children during the summer?

Each camp has its own communication policy. Traditional letters are the best way to communicate with your children. Children love to receive letters while at camp. The camps encourage them to write home at least once a week. Some camps provide an email service. Others allow campers to call home once.

How often is the laundry done?

Laundry is done once a week; campers need to pack for 8-10 days.

Can they bring electronic devices?

Cell phones or electronic devices can be used ONLY during travel days. Children must turn them in when they arrive at camp. Electronic devices are not allowed at camp.

How is the food at camp? What if my child has a food allergy?

Balanced meals are made at camp every day. There are always different options available. Fresh fruits and salads are offered every day. Most camps are able to accommodate a variety of special diets. Please let us know about your child's needs before they are enrolled.

What is the camp lice policy?

All camps have a very strict no nit/lice policy. Head lice infestation is a problem in any communal setting where children are in close contact. It is considered an infectious disease. Children will be carefully checked for head lice on their first day at camp. Any child arriving with nits/lice will be isolated from the group. The Camp will treat the child. The cost is not included in the camp tuition.

What happens if my child gets sick or is injured at camp?

All the camps have an infirmary open 24/7. If a child gets sick, the medical staff will apply her/him a treatment. If necessary, the child will be taken to the nearest hospital.

Does my child need to bring any money?

We recommend parents to provide some pocket money. Children may use it in excursions or at the airport. We suggest something between \$20-\$100.



TRANSPORTATION

Parents are not required to travel with their children. We arrange transportation and make plane reservations with no additional cost to all the campers. To those families who would rather purchase the plane tickets by themselves, we provide the specific flight information. We place a chaperone on the flights that have a minimum of 10 campers. For all the other flights, parents may hire the Unaccompanied Minor service of the airline. We arrange transportation from the airport to camp, and around trip. Parents may also drive their children to camp or pick them up on designated dates.

PAYMENT

Camp tuition should be paid directly to camp by wire transfer, credit card or check (method of payment varies by camp). A deposit must accompany the enrollment form. Parents may pay the balance in full, in two installments or monthly installments. The remaining balance must be paid before May 1st. Camps Overseas fee should be paid by wire transfer.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CAMPS OVERSEAS OFFERS: reservations formalities, information and advising, flights and enrollment in the selected course. We also provide exhaustive information about each program, a chaperone (optional), student monitoring during the course or at the camp, reporting on time to parents of potential incidents, and we are always counting on personnel in the US. Enrollment in any of the camps has a management fee of 475€ + VAT.

BOOKING: It becomes effective after the tuition's payment and registration has been sent to the camp. The payment will be made according to the stipulated form of the chosen camp.

FINAL PAYMENT: The total amount must be paid before the beginning of the camp and in accordance to the specified conditions of each camp.

CANCELLATIONS: All cancellations must be communicated by registered mail, fax or email. Camps Overseas abides to the cancellation rules established by each camp. Camps Overseas reserves the right to cancel any of the reservations for any of the following reasons:

- Forced majored.
- When the camp advises us to do so.
- The selected courses are not considered contractual until final confirmation has been made by the principal's office of the camp, regardless of filling the registration form and subscribing the management fee.



- When for reasons not relevant to Camps Overseas, it would not be possible to offer the previously agreed vacancies at the camps we will try to provide a program with similar characteristics. Failure to accept the change, will immediately cancel the registration with the corresponding monetary refund.

Not including what is stated above, the 475€ + VAT management fee for Camps Overseas will not be refunded under any circumstances.

STARTING DATE MODIFICATION: Camps Overseas is not responsible for any modifications occurred in the enrolled courses program. Therefore, the camps reserve the right to change the dates and the tuition fees. In these cases, the costs brought about by the changes in transportation or lodging is assigned to students.

NOT INCLUDED ON THE PRICE:

- Plane ticket and transfers from the airport to the camp.
- Airline tickets shall be the buyer's responsibility or, by request, Camps Overseas', free of charge. This offer will count on the services of a travel agent, acting solely as an intermediary of the airline companies that subcontracts. Therefore, they cannot be held responsible for delays, changes in flights, accidents or luggage lost.
- Escort on the flight: We provide an escort service to the destination airport as long as there are at least ten participants in each flight, departing and arriving at the same location and this service entails an additional cost. In all other cases, if the student is a minor, traveling with a chaperon from the airline is mandatory, cost what it may. In the event that the family considers the child to be chaperoned by a monitor or a responsible adult regardless of the number of youngsters, the family will bear the cost of that service.
- Depending on the camps, there may be several activities and additional options that can be contracted (golf, horse riding, hiking, Mass attendance, bed linen rental...).
- Personal expenses such as pocket money or specific material are required by the camp.
- Uniforms are mandatory in those camps that may require it.
- Any possible charges due to COVID infection: hotel accommodation, hospital fees, medical tests, repatriation...

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The participant is obliged to conform to established standards at the camp and must act in accordance with ethics and customs of the country where he/she is. In case of a serious breach of discipline, repeated misbehavior, or failure to comply with the rules, the participant will be

returned to Spain. All expenses incurred in the return trip and restitution for damages caused to third parties shall be borne by their parents or guardians.

The use of cellular phones at the camps is strictly prohibited.

If students, with their parents or guardians consent, decide at their discretion to leave the camp, the payments are non-refundable.

The organization, operation and services at the camps are the sole responsibility of the entity that provides them.

Camps Overseas acts as an intermediary between the camp and the participant. As collateral for our students, we work only with renowned, prestigious institutions.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- Medical insurance and travel insurance: Camps Overseas is not liable for personal injuries that the campers may suffer during their participation in the selected camp and related activities. All participants must have an insurance policy that covers all the expenses that might incur by accident or disease during his/her stay abroad. In the case of a camp within the EU, it is recommended to obtain the European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). On the assumption that the student would be required to receive medical treatment, be admitted to a hospital, and/or perform surgery on him/her without being able to contact the parents or guardians, the camp board is authorized to take the measures they deem appropriate, after consulting the medical personnel.
- Passport: All participants need a valid passport.
- Visa: for Europeans is called the ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) here:

- All the kids are required to have a health insurance with coverage in the USA while at camp.

Camps Overseas will take care of all claims submitted in writing.

If in subsequent years a student repeats assistance to a camp recommended by Camps Overseas, he / she will commit to inform us and pay the management expenses. Registration and participation in any Camps Overseas program implies the total acceptance of these conditions every year in which you attend.
